Admission and Matriculation Requirements

Candidates for the undergraduate programme shall be accepted at the 100 level, for a four-year programme, and in 200 level, as direct entry applicants, for a three-year course.

UTME O/Level Requirements for Admission to 100 Level (Year 1)

Admission into the programme, at the 100 level, will ordinarily be based on the candidate's performance at both the Unified Tertiary Matriculation Examination (UTME) and the entrance interview of the University. In addition, the candidate should possess Credit passes in 5 Senior Secondary Certificate (SSC) subjects or its equivalent including Mathematics, English Language and three other arts or social science subjects at not more than two sittings.

UTME Subjects

Use of English, any three (3) from Arts or Social Science subjects.

Direct Entry Requirements for Admission to 200 Level (Year 2)

To gain admission into the 200 level, the candidate, in addition to passing the evaluative interview of the Pan-Atlantic University, will need to possess:

- (I) 3 A/Level credit passes in arts or social science subjects.
- (ii) A pass at merit level in Mass Communication, Journalism or related disciplines (provided the 'O' Level requirements are satisfied).
